An unusual 18th.Century style walnut corner cupboard. The arch shaped top with cross grain mouldings above the unusual verre eglomise glass with gilded and faux tortoiseshell decoration. The single door with conforming painted glass and cross grain astragals. The door opens to reveal a re-lined interior with plate glass shelves. The lower section with moulded swept top above the single cross banded and feather banded drawer with etched brass 18th.C style brass handles. Below are 2 conforming inlaid and banded doors with brass escutcheon and working lock & key. The cabinet has a shaped apron and is raised on well turned legs with shaped stretchers and bun feet.
