Description

A gorgeous English leather armchair dating from the late 19th Century. It is well made and a good comfortable chair with a deep sprung seat. It has a gently leaning buttoned back with a scroll top and the back is also sprung for comfort. It is a lovely shape with good proportions and stands on turned front feet and square back feet with four ceramic castors. It is horse-hair stuffed, quite possibly the original. The webbing and bottom hessian covering has been recently replaced giving a good firm seat. It is in good condition for its age. The leather is original and has developed a lovely worn and aged patina. It is structurally sound with minimal play in the frame and the springs are good. There are no major damages in the leather but there is a small old repaired split on the back of the scroll top and another small old repair near the arm on the seat. The back and sides are all in good order with no rips or tears, just some slight marks on the back where the springs push against it. There are signs of historic woodworm in the legs and front of the arms which has all been treated as a precaution and has not affected the chair structurally or aesthetically. There are wh...
