The top is hinged and opens to reveal the hallmarks for the Birmingham Assay Office with a date mark for 1911 and the Lion Passant indicating the finest sterling silver along with the maker's mark for Adie & Lovekin. The back of the Case is also engraved in the same style and has an empty cartouch in the centre. There is a loop on one side for attachment. An exceptionally nicely engraved Stamp Case. Condition: This case is in lovely antique condition. There are some slight surface marks to the inside of the case when the lid is opened commensurate with age and use. Measurements: Height: 2.2 cm approx. Width: 2.8 cm approx. (not including loop attached). Depth: 4.4 mm approx Weight: 5.1 grams approx.
