Description

Signed oil on canvas by the artist Taf Wallet. The painting shows a still life of fruit and game birds. It is in excellent condition, mounted in a quality frame and signed by the artist and dated 1941. Taf Wallet (1902 - 2001) was a painter, engraver, creator of mosaics and stained glass. Born of Walloon father and Flemish mother. He was a friend and contemporary of Paul Delvaux. He first studied wood and marble at the Industrial School of La Louvière (1916 - 1917) and then studied at the Academy of Mons with A. Durieu and Émile Motte (1920 - 1922) and at the Brussels Academy with Constant Montald, Jean Delville and Émile Fabry (1922 - 1926). He moved to Schaerbeek in 1923 . The Prix Godecharle (1928) enabled him to visit France and Italy in 1930 . In 1933, Wallet lived in Saint-Idesbald and his work underwent a great influence of the sea. He won the price of Hainaut (1934). He painted mainly clear and robust landscapes, beach views, seascapes and still lifes. He painted first in a realistic style, but then, after the second world war his work became more impressionistic. Later, he gave more attention to the composition and elaboration of his subjects.
