The base also incorporating a fielded panel central cupboard again with the original handle, escutcheon and hinge. With quarter mahogany columns to the ends and fielded panels. Supported on shaped ogee bracket feet. English circa 1780 Dimensions: 82" wide x 22" deep x 37" high Condition: This dresser base is in mostly original condition, some of the hinges on the top have been replaced some time in the 19th century.
