The top section with a pair of glazed doors, fitted with beveled plate glass, which open to access a shelved interior. Surmounted by a dentil cornice with a freeze inlaid with swags, garlands and harebells. The base section is of "D-fronted" form, with a pair of cupboard doors opening to reveal a shelved interior. The cupboard doors are decorated with bands of harebells surrounding central motifs. All doors are lockable (keys supplied) and it breaks down into two sections for ease of installation.
