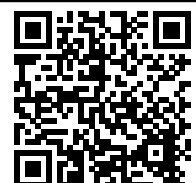

An original vernier adjuster knob. A mercury thermometer. Circa 1870. D Mc Gregor of Glasgow and Greenock are recorded in Banfields' 'Barometer Makers and Retailers' book as working from 1856.
