Raised on reeded fore-legs with turned feet, the classically-inspired carved backs and lumbar splats with honeysuckle motifs and a central carved rose. The design and execution giving a firm attribution to the esteemed cabinet-makers Gillows of Lancaster and London. Interestingly the central rose motif to the top rail bears a strong resemblance to the Lancastrian rose, the motif symbolic of the county and area. Best quality grade of mahogany timber throughout with no damage, breaks or repairs. Excellent rich colour and patina. Recently covered lift-off seats with a well-chosen patterned hard-wearing fabric.
