Description

Signed oil on canvas by the French artist Fernand Joseph Jules Stiévenart (1862 -1922). The painting is painted with a generous loose and vibrant palette and is mounted in a quality gilded frame. It is signed and dated by the artist and has an inscription on the rear. Stiévenart was born in Douai on May 21, 1862 and died in Uccle (Belgium) on January 22, 1922. He was a French landscape painter of the Wissant School on the north of the Opal Coast. He studied at the Lycée du Douai, but developed his talents at the Academic Schools. His first master was Constant Petit. From 1878 to 1880, F. Stiévenart regularly followed the courses of the Academic Schools and each year, in each of the three divisions, won the first medals. He was awarded one of the first at the School of Fine Arts. As early as 1888, he appeared in Paris at the Salon des Artistes Français with works representing landscapes. However, it was in 1893 that he became a member of the Society of French Artists and that he received a eulogy (honorable mention voted unanimously that ranked the first among the mentioned). Shortly after a terrible shipwreck Wissant in 1893, Stiévenart will help Adrien Demont ,...
