Smart quality pair of French late C19th ormolu bronze and white marble cherub candelabras. Ormolu twin branch candelabras modelled as exultant amorini or cherubs each balanced on one leg, wearing draped loin-cloths holding naturalistic rose and bud branches in each hand. The figures raised on white marble cylindrical columns decorated with ormolu bronze swagged floral garlands and laurel-leaf rings, onto square section plinths with shaped re-entrant corners and a gilded bronze slip base. The twin candle-holders of each candelabra designed as rose flower-heads, the 'flower-stem' arms cast with leaf and bud decoration. In excellent original condition with bright, untarnished gilding to the ormolu bronze, and no chips or damage to the marble bases. H 13" W 11" D 4" France c. 1900
