The makers mark is rubbed but looks like it could be C.H for Charles Horner. It is in very good condition for its age. There are some small dinks in the silver top and some general signs of age and use but nothing detrimental. There are no cracks or major damages to the glass just some minor small surface nibbles. It has been cleaned and the silver gently polished and overall it displays very well.
