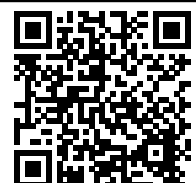
Fine early 19th century mahogany bow-fronted stick barometer by J. Smith*, Royal Exchange, London; the richly coloured casework with a glazed silvered register, a mercury thermometer and an urn-shaped cistern-cover, surmounted by a swan's-neck pediment. *James Smith is known to have been working at North Gate, Royal Exchange from 1815 to 1828. John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940. We are a traditional antiques shop, but very much in the 21st century. We deal in 18th and early 19th century furniture, barometers and clocks. We choose our stock for its originality and for the quality of its colour, patination and design. We are members of the BADA.
