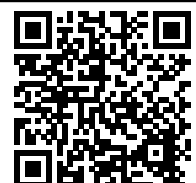

A Somerset Georgian period longcase clock with rocking ship. A walnut case with rosewood crossbanding of pale colour. A swan neck hood pediment with brass paterae and an original central brass finial. Brass capped hood columns. An arched painted dial with ship automaton and coastal scene. A date aperture and seconds dial. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. William Preddy of Langport is recorded in A J Moores 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of Somerset' book as working from 1822-1839. He moved to Bridgwater in 1839. A rocking ship is illustrated in the book. Height 7ft 4 " / 223 cms Width 19 1/2 " / 50 cms Depth 11" / 28 cms.
