The super-structure with a central mirror fitted with its original beveled plate glass (some minor foxing), flanked by two pairs of short drawers and all surmounted with a solid brass gallery. The table is fitted with a sumptuous leather writing surface decorated with gilt tooling to the surround. To the freeze there are 3 drawers, each fitted with their original solid brass pulls. All standing on elegant tapering square legs which terminate in their original brass caps and castors.
