Provenance By direct Family Descent Notes Elizabeth Mitchell, the daughter of Sir Charles Mitchell, married Alexander Cosby Jackson on October 13th 1811 at St. Peter's Church, Colombo, Ceylon. Sir Charles Mitchell was captain in the Naval Service, H.E.I.C., knighted at St James, March 18, 1796, for an action in the Straits of Malacca, with a French frigate, he being then Captain of the "William Pitt," East Indiaman, died suddenly, 24th March 1808. He married at Calcutta about 1788, Sarah, daughter of Thomas Patterson, who died 17th July 1803, and had issue 1. Charles, (only son), born at London, 13th July, 1789, an officer in H.E.I.C.S., died unmarried 2. Elizabeth Katherine, born 28th November, 1792, married in Ceylon, 1812, Alexander Cosby Jackson of Edmonton, Middlesex, Colonel 40th Foot, and had issue (a) Sir Charles Robert Mitchell Jackson, born 1813, Judge of Supreme Court of India, died 1874, married 1844, Jane, daughter of Edward Armitage of Farnley Hall, Yorks, and had issue; Charles William Leathley, clerk of Insolvent Cou...
