Description

Late C19th Anglo-Indian Hoshiarpur ivory inlaid octagonal 'shisham' table. Profusely ivory-inlaid Indian octagonal top occasional table on hinged and folding base. The centre with elaborate inlaid circular panel with ebony band, surrounded by further ivory decoration of trailing vines and flower-heads with ebony line banding, the edges ivory inlaid motifs. The edge of the top with a gently bevelled profile, inlaid with ivory star-type motifs. The folding base with 8 hinged and 'mihrab' arch arcaded sides each inlaid with corresponding ivory decoration. The underside with two twisting cleats to secure the top in position. Evidence of old manufacturer's brown paper retail labels. In excellent original condition, the timber having achieved a pleasing faded mellow patination. H 20" W 20" D 20" India c. 1890
