The inside has a drainer which sits on a rim on the interior, allowing melted ice to drain, keeping the ice dry. This is of nautical interest. engraved to the front for the New Zealand Shipping Company. The New Zealand Shipping Company (NZSC) was a shipping company whose ships ran passenger and cargo services between Great Britain and New Zealand between 1873 and 1973.
