Beautiful early 19th.c. corner cupboard with exceptional inlaid front c.1810. Oak door panel inlaid in various contrasting timbers with a compass motif at the centre with wavy points half way between the quarters which are repeated at the corners of the panel. Surrounding the centre panel is a stunning display of craftsmanship with multiple concentric bands of inlaid tunbridge ware type detail in ebony and boxwood plus rosewood and mahogany crossbanding and inlaid stringing and moulding which continue on the door surround, cornice and base moulding. Open the door to reveal two oak shelves, oak back boards and door all retaining attractively worn original paintwork. Decorative pierced and gilded brass escutcheon, original lock and key. Excellent colour and condition. Dimensions: width 33", depth to corner 23", height 37½".
