It is finely modelled in ormolu (finely gilded bronze), beautifully finished and in stunning condition. It is mounted with Sevres style porcelain, each piece is signed faintly on the reverse by the artist. It is decorated with a pompadour rose pink background, the panel below the dial is delicately painted with a scene of a young couple in a country scene with panels of floral swags to each side. The dial is decorated with a cherub with with musical instruments. It is lettered in white cartouches against the pink background with turquoise coloured enamel 'jewel' half-hour markers. The rear door is glazed with convex frosted glass. (Please note that this style of clock does not have a glazed bezel over the dial). The French movement is by Japy Freres and has the makers mark on the backplate. It is of high quality and is in excellent clean and running condition having been fully overhauled by our clockmaker. Pendulum is original. The movement is fitted with the superior rack striking system. It runs for 8 days and strikes the...
