This is a super pair of antique Edwardian hallmarked sterling silver shell butter dishes with knives in their original presentation case. Each dish measures 3 3/4" (9.5 cms) x 3 1/2" (9 cms) and the knives are just over 4" (10 cms) long. They all show the silversmiths mark for Henry Atkin and the dishes are hallmarked for Sheffield 1907 with the knives hallmarked for Sheffield 1906. The case is marked inside 'The Liverpool Goldsmiths Company' and everything is in excellent condition. The dishes are gilded and there are no inscriptions or monograms - the silver alone weighs 90 grams. Free worldwide fully insured shipping included in the price.
