## Description

A fine Japanese porcelain bowl, Arita, late 17th / early 18th Century. Beautifully painted in 'Imari' style, with a continuous scene of flowering plants growing amongst rocks, in underglaze blue, green, yellow, iron red, and heightened in gilt; above a narrow band of meandering floral scroll. The interior, with a circular panel, containing a further flowering plant, beneath a border of flower heads and alternating panels of floral scroll, and gilt chevron, upon an underglaze blue ground. Diameter - 14 cm, 5 1/2". Height - 6.7 cm, 2 5/8". Condition - Very minor typical wear to the gilding. No damage. No restoration.
