Description

Gents antique silver wrist watch, Christmas 1923. The watch has a Swiss hand-winding movement, identified as by Fontainemelon, which is working nicely. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover which has an inscription, 'To Dick from Cecil, Xmas 1923'. The watch measures 35mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the fixed wire lugs. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside the case backs for London (import mark) 1922 with an importer's mark for George Stockwell. From 1 June 1907, Stockwells acted as assay agents, facilitating the import into Britain of foreign gold and silver items, which had to be assayed and hallmarked in a UK assay office before being released for retail. The front of the case is in good condition. The hinged case back has some unevenness but overall the condition is very acceptable for such an early piece. The winding crown is a later replacement. The lens is in lovely condition. The dial is in good condition, just a small hairline towards the bottom. Blue steel hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and an outer minute track. A new leather strap has been fitted. The watch will be sent in a new presentation box.
