Description

Large antique English silver pocket watch and albert. The watch has a key-wound movement which is working nicely. The movement is from one of the many Coventry watch makers, and it is signed with the name of the original retailer, Harris Stone, Leeds. The movement is protected by an inner fitted cover. Harris Stone was born in Russia in 1863. He emigrated to the UK and set up a successful jewellery business within the city of Leeds, from where he traded until the post War years. The watch measures 57mm diameter excluding the stem and the loop so it is larger than a standard 50mm pocket watch, the type of watch worn by landowners or industrialists. The case is silver and there are hallmarks inside both of the case backs for Birmingham 1910, with a case maker's mark for the Birmingham based Dennison Watch Case Company, a prolific manufacturer of cases for various watch makers. The case is in good condition, originally there would have been engine turned detail to the case back but this has worn off with years of use. The acrylic lens is in good condition. The dial is signed with the Harris Stone, Leeds name. There are several hairline cracks to the dial but they...
