They come complete in the original retailer's (Page Keen & Page) wooden box. Page Keen & Page of Plymouth held a Royal appointment and supplied high quality silver for naval and civil ceremonies. These menu holders which are designed as a Naval Crown could also be used to display a photograph, business card or party invitation and looks very nice on display just on it's own.
