Description

Early C19th Baltic region mahogany-framed pier mirror with parcel-gilt column caps and base terminals. Smart architecturally-inspired mahogany-framed pier or trumeau mirror with flat pilasters above full-length half-round columns to the margins with gilded elements and a shaped, scrolling pediment above a richly-figured inset panel or tympanum section. The base with a figured mahogany skirting-board panel of breakfront outline. Good clear original mirror-plate and richly patinated mahogany frame. The original gilding with carved and incised detail together with a gently burnished patina and colour. Minor historic repairs to the veneered edge of the base area. The reverse fitted with the original backboards. A bold pier or hall mirror of architectural form in excellent original 'untouched' condition. H 74" W 30" D 4" Baltic, probably Sweden c. 1825
