Very stylish and fine early Victorian silver decanter label ornately shaped as a vine leaf complete with textured detail and veins. The label is for "Sherry" which is punched through the leaf, and is fitted with a belcher chain. Hallmarked for London 1838, makers Charles Reily and George Storer. It measures 6.5cm (2 1/2") wide and 4.5cm (1 3/4") high and approx. 12cm (4 3/4") from the top of the chain to the bottom of the label. It weighs 18g / 0.6ozt. Condition is excellent with no damage or repairs and minimal surface wear.
