Broad central beam and a pair of internal staves fortify the lid. Maker's mark stamped into the leading edge - S. Hunt & Sons, Ironmongers, Liverpool. Each side dressed with a loop handle for carriage. Left-hand handle featuring a repository label for Harvey Nichols in Bournemouth.
