A maveulous vintage ruby ring. The oval cut centre stone displays a rich, deep pigeon blood red and is rubover set in milgrained yellow gold. Twenty white and bright rose cut diamond are set in the platinum surround, above a striking vented gallery. The cluster sits on a slim and tapering yellow gold shank, with swirling cheniers under the shoulders. Accompanied by an independent jewellery report from IGR (#30308745). Cut - Oval cut ruby and rose cut diamonds. Colour - The diamonds are F to H. Clarity - The diamonds are VS2 to SI1. Carat - The ruby is a known 3.43 carat, with a total approximate diamond weight of 0.40 carat. Circa - 1920. Size - N 1/2 (UK) or 6.75 (US). Complimentary sizing is available, can be sized up or down. Measurements - The head of the ring is 15.7 x 13.2mm. Sits 5mm from the finger. Metal - Stamped 18CT&PT - 18k yellow gold and platinum - and tests as such.
