Single very small slither on outside rim which is insignificant. **Dimensions** Height: 15.5cm Diameter: 21.5cm. Weight 1368 grams. **Technical Description** A Webb cameo fleur vase. The rim features notch cutting cut through green to clear. A waisted body is decorated with lilies using the cameo cut-back technique. The Webb mark is also present by means of this technique. **Historical Relevance** Handcrafted around the time of the Great Depression which began in 1929 lasting to the late '30s.

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
