The tapered body designed to hold a small silver thimble. It is embossed all over with foliate decorations surrounding vacant cartouches. The sides fitted with a chain. It was probably originally part of a Victorian silver chatelaine. The interior lined with velvet. Hallmarks: LS for Lionel Spiers. Lion Passant. Birmingham Assay Mark. Date letter "o" for 1888.
