Description

Signed oil on canvas by Paul Leduc (1876-1945). The painting shows a stunning view of a bridge and has a wonderful tonal quality. It is framed and mounted in a quality wooden hand finished frame. Paul Leduc was a Belgian impressionist and luminist inspired by French artists and with a predilection for landscapes and urban views. He was born on 28th August 1876 in La Louvière, the industrial area of Hainaut province. He was a student of Antoine Bourlard at the Academy of Mons between 1891 and 1896 and later studied under Albert Baertsoen at NHISKA, the academy of Anvers. He began working in the company of J. Coosemans students in Tervuren. He painted scenes of Belgian and Holland but he mostly painted in the south of France and Italy. His paintings notably portrayed bays, rivers, canals and bridges. His work can be found in Royal collections and in the museum of Charleroi, Schaerbeek, Ixelles, Mons, Frankfurt, Bucharest, Buenos Aires, Rio de Janeiro, and Brussels. He has also received several honours including the Médaille du Roi Albert, Chevalier de l'Ordre de la Couronne, Chevalier de l'Ordre de Léopold, Chevalier de l'Ordre de Roumanie, Bucarest.
