The clock has an eight inch painted dish dial with the makers name:- John B Cross ?London The movement is a five pillar, eight day, twin fusee on chain with pull repeat action, strike - silent mechanism, anchor escapement, top pendulum adjustment and holdfast. The clock strikes the hours on a bell and the back plate is engraved with the makers name. John Berryhill Cross was born in 1805. His father John Cross was also a clock and watch maker. The clock movement has been cleaned and serviced and comes with a 12 month guarantee. Height - 16 ½ inches Width - 12 inches Depth - 7 ½ inches Circa - 1835
