The interior is again top-notch and would have contained some cologne bottles to the rear. All beautifully leather lined with a removable tray & various compartments. The lid is lined with a rich green velvet which falls forward with an integral compartment for papers and the original mirror behind. The top of the box has a highly decorative brass inlaid plate with three decorative initials F B P. The box has a Bramah lock, a sign of top quality but alas, no key.
