The clock has a white enamel dial with gilt Roman numerals and a French eight day movement which strikes the hours and half hours on a bell. The movement back plate is stamped with the makers name:- Japy Freres The dial has the retailers name:- Howell James & Co To The Queen Paris Howell James & Company were jewellers and silversmiths based in Regent Street in London which operated between 1819 and 1911. They showed at the London and Paris exhibitions. The clock movement has been cleaned and serviced and comes with a 12 month guarantee.
