This alternating patterned bracelet is quite weighty and is linked with a rail track affair of chrome circular balls and alternate lines of black and red enamel rods. About Jakob Bengel Jakob Bengel was a chain and costume jewellery factory, founded by Jakob Bengel in 1873 in Idar-Oberstein, Germany. Until 1920, the company specialised in the production of watch chains and chatelaines. In the 1920's and 1930's, it became one of the leading manufacturers of fashion jewellery in the Art Deco style
