A single weight driven timepiece mechanism with regulator type pendulum and brass cased weight. A tapered plated mechanism of 8-day duration, non striking. Thomas Saunders of London is recorded in Baillies 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of the World' book as working from 1792-1824.
