Description

This fine example of a French carriage clock has the unusual feature of also being an alarm clock. It is in superb condition with its original decorative gilt case with raised hobnail mouldings to most surfaces. It has an eight-day movement. The clock has fine silvered original dials with a gilt mask. The main dial is enhanced with raised and cast gilt ornamentation. The smaller one is for setting the alarm which rings on a bell which is housed under the case. The escapement at some point has been changed with a good quality replacement. The clock is in good working condition with key. Circa 1900
