A lovely small pine desk dating from the late 19th century. It has 9 drawers arranged around a central kneehole, each with a small wooden knob. There is a small gallery across the back of the desk and it stands on turned bun feet. It has nice small proportions and the kneehole measures approximately 23 1/2" / 60cm high x 14 1/2" / 37cm. The desk is in good condition for its age and has been well looked after. It has a lovely warm patina and the pine has mellowed to a pleasant colour over time. The drawers open well and are generally clean and tidy inside. There are some marks and old stains on the top but nothing untoward for a desk of this age. There is some wear to the bottom of one back foot and a small chip in the back side piece of molding but nothing detrimental. The desk has been cleaned, gently polished and displays beautifully and is ready for use.
