The hinged lid with a vacant plaque and fitted with a silk pouch and a mirror flanked by engraved brass hinged and locking bar. Over five glass jars and bottles with engine turned silver lids each with a monogram and with two lift-out trays with steel and ivory handled utensils above a leather lined compartment fitted brush boxes, compartments and an ivory shoe horn and a comb. The hinged fall front stamped with maker's mark 'A.C. PARIS' revealing a plush lined drawer with four divisions. The base with a leather trade label for 'A. CHRISTOPHE RUE DU TEMPLE 33 PARIS'.
