The classic slim walnut case has a straight hood with fine blind fret decoration to the upper corners. The glazed door opens to allow you to wind the clock through the 2 apertures in the clock dial. The brass dial with fine quality cast spandrels and a silvered chapter ring, an applied makers nameplate and a date aperture. The longcase clocks trunk with the moulded long door that opens to reveal the weights and the pendulum. This majestic clock runs for 8 days and so you can enjoy winding it with the crank key once a week.
