Description

Mid C19th cast-iron country house stick or umbrella stand of gothic design. Well-proportioned large cast-iron stick-stand with gothic tracery pattern cast upright ends with integrally cast handles and finial tops. The open top cast and divided with 24 circular apertures providing space for multiple sticks, canes, riding crops or umbrellas. The divided base section fitted with 2 detachable/removable 'drip' trays, which have been skilfully re-manufactured and replaced to the exact design of the broken and worn originals. The stepped out corners of the multi-stepped design base raised on integrally cast feet. The reverse with a flatter profile to fit closer to a wall or skirting board. Probably designed for the hallway of a country house or perhaps club. In excellent condition with no breaks, damage or repairs. Has an apparently original black painted finish, and benefits from not having had multiple layers of paint applied to obscure the detailed casting. H 23" W 37" D 13" England c.1860
