George IV period mahogany knee-hole desk; the front with nine mahogany-lined drawers and the reverse with three dummy drawers above a pair of shelved cupboards with panelled doors, all with later brass-knob handles; the top lined with gold-tooled green hide. The leather was replaced some twenty years ago and shows signs of use. Circa 1830 John Beazor Antiques is a family firm, established in 1875 and based in Cambridge since 1940.
