Nice shape sunk in carrying handles to the sides. Nice shape name plate in the top with the name of J DES VOEUX engraved upon it. We believe this is HENRY JOHN DE VOEUX who was born in 1876 and was a colonial in the first world war amongst other wars he fought in. He was related to the famous Sir William Des Voeux who was the colonial Governor of Hogn Kong in the 19th century. The box has a pleasing fitted interior which looks original to me, no decanters.
