Description

An early provincial automaton 'cottage' longcase clock in a pine case by Issac Tinson, Layburn. A flat moulded hood pediment with gilded column capitals. A high quality brass and silvered dial with the original single hand layout. A matted dial centre with date aperture and 'rocking eyes' automaton to the engraved face. A 30 hour mechanism of good construction striking the hours on a bell. The place name 'Layburn' is presumably the old spelling of 'Leyburn' in Yorkshire. Height 6ft 2 " / 188 cms
