A fine early 19th century west country Windsor chair of large proportions with a good broad elm seat, similar examples of this chair attributed to Cullompton, Devon - can be found in The English regional chair book by Bernard D.Cotton, Figures SW23-SW25 - SW27 page 270. The upper section of the chair is constructed from elm and ash, with the lower section having finely turned fruit wood legs. To the back of the elm seat there is a makers stamp L.W. The chair has fabulous colour and patination and is in excellent condition. Seat Height 43cm x Width 53.5cm tapering to 41cm x Depth 41cm Overall height 115cm x Width 68cm x Depth 52cm
