Description

This rug was woven in Central Anatolia around 1850 in the ancient city of Ladik where rugs in a very similar style were woven for hundreds of years. Ladik rugs have an austere and noble attraction. This example typically has a row of tulips, but has an unusual field of highly graphic geometric ornaments. The overall composition is very appealing, including a stylised floral border. The condition is as one would expect for a rug of such great age, with several old repairs, but retains its charm and character, and is still in very usable condition.
