An oak case with mahogany crossbanding and line inlays. Fluted trunk side columns and a mahogany panel. A raised mahogany crossbanded panel to the base. An attractive arched painted dial with gilt corners and lunar moon phases to the arch. A seconds dial and date aperture. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. Circa 1840. Edwin Sawtell is listed in A J Moores 'Bristol Clockmakers' book having worked at the Horsefair and Bridewell Street in Bristol from 1838.
