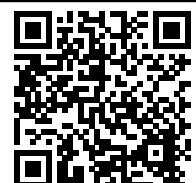
Description

This finely sculptured study of a powerful and muscular panther standing tensed ready to attack with strong clawed paws and a wide snarling mouth showing a dangerous array of teeth. This is a fine example of Thomas Francois Cartier's work who specialised in animal bronzes, particularly big cats. Tomas Cartier (1879 1943) was born in Marseilles, France. He later studied under Georges Gardet gaining skill and experience. He specialised in animal sculptures. Cartier regularly exhibited at the Salon and was awarded a gold medal in 1927. This fine study is in wonderful condition with dark green patination. Circa 1910
