Description

Pair of early C19th George IV period mahogany hall chairs of Grecian revival design. Well-carved pair of mahogany hall or footman's chairs raised on tapering octagonal forelegs. The backs with lower scrolling leaf-carved detail below a vacant armorial cartouche shield. The top rails with a tightly-carved pedimented classically-inspired cresting of ancient Grecian inspiration in the high fashion of the period. The solid mahogany seats of gently tapered form with cut corners. Scalloped hand or finger grip 'handles' to the rear of backs for ease of movement. Excellent original patina and colour to the superior grade of selected dense timber. Minor historic repair to one rear support, not compromising strength or stability. H (back) 34" H (seat) 17.5" W 14.5" England c.1825
