A satinwood Edwardian Period serpentine antique display cabinet by Maple & Co. The upper section with a broken swan neck pediment with shell inlaid paterae above a central rectangular glazed door, enclosing a silk shelved interior. Flanked by serpentine glazed panels with ebony and string inlay. The lower section has three panelled doors cross banded in satinwood with ebony and satinwood inlaid detail, enclosing a shelved interior. Supported on six elegant square tapering supports with spade feet. Having the makers label Maple & Co. English circa 1900 Dimensions: 88" high x 50" wide x 18" deep With a warehouse that was one of the "sites of London", Maple & Co was once the largest furniture retailer and manufacturer in the world, attracting visitors from near and far. The company was most prolific in the late Victorian and Edwardian era, specialising in fine quality Arts & Crafts Furniture, designed and produced in their own workshops. However, they continued producing fine quality furniture up until the 1980s. Condition: This cabinet is in excellent original condition, cleaned and waxed. Minor staining to the silk lined shelves commensurate with age and use.

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
